Amendment to Bye Law 15.11 on Limitation Period for Reference to Arbitration

In terms of the provisions of Rules, Bye-laws and Business Rules of the Exchange, Members of the Exchange are hereby notified pursuant to the approval of Forward Markets Commission vide its letter No.2/3/2008-MKT-Amend/MCX dated January 18, 2012, the limitation period for referring the claims/differences/ disputes to Arbitration under the Bye law 15.11 of the Exchange has been extended to <u>three</u> <u>years</u> from the existing period of one year.

A copy of the revised Bye law 15.11 of the Exchange, duly published in the Official Gazette of India vide notification dated March 31 – April 6, 2012 (weekly), Part IV, at page No. 227 (Hindi version) page 235 (English version), is attached herewith as Annexure and the same shall come into force from the date of its notification in the Gazette of India, i.e. March 31, 2012.
